Dear NCS Club Delegate,

Welcome to the wonderful world of exhibiting cockatiels. Enclosed is all the information and forms that you need to get your Club affiliated as a new or renewed NCS Affiliated Club.

1. The Club Affiliation Information Sheet which explains the requirements and benefits to affiliate with NCS along with the Show Awards for each level of affiliation.
2. The Club Affiliation Form used to affiliate your club.
3. The Affiliated Club Show Information Form.
4. A list of current NCS Judges with their addresses and phone numbers.
5. A NCS Advertisement for use in your show catalog.
6. The NCS Standard with a Show Point Chart containing suggestions for class listings for your show.
7. Advanced Exhibitor Band Listings.
8. Regional & Specialty Show Guidelines and Application

It is highly recommended that the Club and Show affiliation be established at least 120 days prior to the show to permit time for publicity in the NCS Journal and website. You may delay sending the Affiliated Club Show Information Form until you have all information needed; however, it should be received as early as possible if it is to appear in the NCS Journal and on the NCS website, [www.cockatiels.org](http://www.cockatiels.org). This information is required so NCS can order awards in a timely fashion. We would appreciate that your Club Affiliation is submitted as early in the year as possible even though affiliations are accepted throughout the year.

- NCS Regional Shows and an annual Specialty Show: Clubs must submit an application to host these shows. The Board of Directors will make final acceptance decisions by April 1, 2010. Please review the attached criteria and forms if your club is interested in applying to host a Regional or Specialty Show. Applications for 2010 must be submitted by September 30, 2009.
- Rare Classes: Section 7 & 14: All AOV classes have been removed.
- Clubs that affiliate before April 15<sup>th</sup>, are to receive a complimentary half-page ad for their show, also contingent on affiliation being received more than 120 days to the event. (Inside 120 days to the event is at the discretion of the Journal Editor due to time and space restrictions).

It is recommended that the material provided in this package be used to create your show program. Electronic copies of the NCS Standard, Show Point Chart are available upon request and on the NCS website, [www.cockatiels.org](http://www.cockatiels.org), to affiliated clubs, to assist in producing your show catalog. Please check your club listings in the NCS Journal and website to confirm all information is accurate.

### NCS Affiliated Club

Cost: \$30.00 per year

Benefits:

1. One subscription to the NCS Journal. This is mailed to the Club Delegate or Club Designated mailing address.
2. Your Club and club's NCS delegate are included in the 'Affiliated Clubs' listing of each issue of the NCS Journal and on our website, [www.cockatiels.org](http://www.cockatiels.org).
3. This fee is paid once a year no matter how many shows a club sponsors.

### NCS Affiliated Show

To host one or more NCS-Affiliated Show(s), a club must:

1. Be an NCS-Affiliated Club by paying the \$30.00 Club Affiliation Fee.
2. Employ a judge from the NCS Panel of Judges.
3. Affiliate each show at one of the three Show Affiliation Levels, at the following additional costs:  
Class A: \$100.00  
Class B: \$60.00  
Class C: \$20.00

### Benefits for All Show Classes

1. Club name, show date, location, affiliation class, NCS Judge and Show Delegate information will be included in the Show Calendar published in each issue of the NCS Journal and on the NCS website.
2. The Show Report of the winning birds and their owners will be published in one issue of the NCS Journal and will be posted on the website.
3. Championship points will be awarded in accordance with the NCS 'Table of Points'.
4. Awards (NCS Plaques) will be provided according to affiliation class:

A	2	Best-in-Show (BIS) Best Novice (BN)
B	Club Choice	Best-in-Show and Best Novice <b>OR</b> 1 <sup>st</sup> -10 <sup>th</sup> BIS Rosettes and 1 <sup>st</sup> – 10 <sup>th</sup> BN Rosettes
C	0	Points only

### Additional Class 'A' Show Benefits

1. Each bird on the Top Bench earns one additional point, the Top 10 Best In Show.
2. NCS supplies Top 1st-10th 'Best Novice' Rosettes and Top 1st-10th 'Best In Show' Rosettes.
